The **National Cadet Corps** is the Indian military cadet corps with its Headquarters at New Delhi, Delhi, India. It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps.



### **CLASSES:**

Study, learning & practice is precious in everyone's life. It's important because it is essential for a person to develop. In lieu of it, during the academic year N.C.C classes are held on every Thursday and Friday after the college hours from 3.30 pm till 5:00 pm.
