ST. ANN'S COLLEGE HOSTEL:

St.Ann's College hostel is a home away from home for those who aspire to receive holistic education and have joined the college from far and wide. Admission to the hostel is possible only for those students who study in St.Ann's College. Hostel has the facility of total 270 beds which includes special rooms and common rooms.

Sr.Jayaseela is the warden and she is being assisted by Sr. Ruby and Miss. Kirti . Rising bell goes at 5.00 am accompanied by devotional songs for half an hour. Strict study for two hours followed by breakfast at 7.30. There after the students get themselves ready for the college. Once they are back from the college the study begin from 5.00 p.m. to 7.30 p.m. Strict study continues from 8.p.m. 10 p.m. Specified timings are fixed for washing their cloths and cleaning their rooms. They are given different timings to contact their parents through telephone facilities. Leaders are selected and given different responsibilities for the smooth functioning of the hostel. Warden and Asst. Warden are always at their disposal. Inmates are directed and guided well by them. Personal care is given to each child. Students are free to express their views and ideas.

The menu is well planed and fixed according to the suggestions given by the students and the inmates are trained and directed well to care for them. When a student falls sick first aid is provided by warden sisters and they are taken to the hospital despite of time inconvenient. Free and concessions are given to the deserving students.

CATHOLIC AND CHRISTIAN STUDENTS:

The students take active part in daily Eucharistic celebrations in the parish by singing, reading and conducting prayer service and pray the Holy Rosary daily in our Chapel. The chapel is opened for them to make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament and to read the Word of God. All the others too feel the need for God and spent time in prayer. Our students also take part in different activities conducted in the diocese. They attend catechism classes in the college along with other catholic students. Always study hour begins by invoking the presence of God..
