HOW TO APPLY: Application Forms can be obtained from the College Office on payment of Rs. 100/- + Postage if requested by Post. (Postal charges etc.) Application Forms will be issued only after the publication of S.S.C. Results.

- Application should be registered at the College Office before the prescribed date.
- The following original Certificates + 3 xerox copies of the same should be submitted along with the application. Incomplete Application Forms will be rejected.
- 1. Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate, Marks of the qualifying examination, i.e. S.S.C., I.C.S.E. or C.B.S.E.
- 2. Date of Birth extract. (In case the date of birth is not noted in the certificate.
- 3. 10th Class Hall-Ticket Xerox and Aadhaar Card of Student, Father & Mother.
- 4. The Catholic students should submit a certificate from the Parish Priest and Christian students from the Pastor.
- 5. Migration certificate if students are from other State/other Board Candidates seeking admission should be accompanied by a responsible person, Parent or Guardian. Once admitted, the admission cannot be cancelled and the T.C. can't be issued unless it is a genuine case of transfer of the Parents or the college itself issues, T.C. for serious reasons.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

The students through their application enter voluntarily into an agreement to abide by the rules and regulations of the college.

- 1. The day begins with a common morning prayer in which all participate.
- 2. The College expects the students to be punctual and regular in attendance for all classes. They are in their class rooms at the first bell which goes 10 minutes before the commencement of the morning/evening sessions. College timings: 9.00 to 3.30 p.m.
- 3. A day's attendance requires present at all lectures at both sessions.
- 4. The absentees get previous permission from the Principal. Both the hostel and day students notify their absence from lectures to the Principal through leave notes. Absence without leave notes is subject to penalty.
- 5. Students are to have 80% of the total attendance fixed for each course.
- 6. Students do not leave the college premises during sessions without the permission of the Principal.
- 7. The day students do not enter the hostel quarters.
- 8. Prior permission of the Principal is essential to hold any meeting or gathering in the college premises.
- 9. No books, magazines or newspapers which are in no way related to classes/studies are brought into the campus.
- 10. Students of St.Ann's are to be extra courteous, sensitive, alert, service minded, polite and lady-like in their behaviour.
- 11. Students are expected to be modest in their behaviour and in their dressing. Short sleeves, low necklines, high blouses and low hips are not permitted.
- 12. Electronic gadgets like cell phone, I pads, pocket radio are strictly forbidden. Disobedience of this leads to punishment.
- 13. Parents are requested to attend to all the student welfare meetings conducted by the college.
- 14. On all working days except for College functions, the students should wear the Uniform, I.D. The Uniform will be available in the College.
- 15. No collection/subscription of any kind is allowed without the knowledge and consent of the Principal.
- 16. Change of phone number, residence/address of the students is notified to the Principal & office without delay.
- 17. To meet the Principal timings 2.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m.

The Hostel is attached to the college, and is meant to accommodate students of the St.Ann's College whose parents reside outside the city limits. The hostel is under the direct management of the college authorities.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE HOSTEL

I.ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL

- Admission to the Hostel is made through the principal after the enrolment in the college.
- The Local guardian should be introduced to the Hostel warden sister at the time of admission; The warden sister may have recourse to her in any emergency situation concerning the student. She should be a responsible person; residing in the city and not another student or relative studying in St.Ann's College or any other College.
- Parent, Local guardian and the student should be present at the time of admission.
- Admission to the Hostel is made for ONE YEAR at a time. Continuity of stay will be intimated to the student at the discretion of the concerned authority based on the conduct and academic ability of the student.
- Parents / Guardian are not allowed to stay in the hostel.
- Every parent of the hostel student should attend the parents meet organised by the management without fail.
- No student shall maintain phones or any electronic gadgets. The phone has to be deposited with hostel warden after a written permission and NOC from Parents.
 - Married students are not allowed to the hostel.
 - The students who go against the terms and conditions of the hostel will be dismissed
 - Students with any prolonged illness will not be admitted to the hostel. If anyone is admitted without intimation to the warden sister, the admission will be cancelled immediately.
 - Meeting students by parents/relatives/friends other than the allotted time within/ outside hostel is not permitted. If found, the student will be dismissed from the hostel.

II. REQUIREMENTS

- Thin mattress, Pillow, Mosquito nets, bed sheets (4 sheets), one plastic bucket, one mug, solid linen bag, umbrella, battery torch(not charge), padlock, plate, glass, ginni, etc.
- Students are expected to be careful with their belongings, books, money, clothes jewellery etc. should be locked in the cupboards provided the keys are to be kept with the students at all times. The <u>management</u> is not <u>responsible</u> for articles / money <u>lost or stolen</u>.
- Students are not permitted to go into the rooms of other students.
- Students must not demand special services from the hostel servants. Any complaints against them should be made to the warden sisters. Students should not offer money, clothes etc to the servants.
- Students are expected to be <u>neat and tidy in their habits</u>, avoiding exaggerated fashions. Tight fit dresses, short sleeves, low necklines, and low hips are not permitted.
- Nails must not be driven into the walls of the hostel rooms nor should papers or any stickers pasted on them.

- During this period a strict silence must be maintained in the hostel. Once the lights are turned off at 10.15 pm, strict silence should be continued till the next morning.
- During college working hours hostel students are not allowed in the hostel except for serious reasons with the permission of the warden sister.

IV. VISITS & OUTINGS

- Visitors and Non-resident students are not allowed to visit the hostel rooms.
- Resident students may receive visits from the parents, local guardian and other visitors whom
 the parents have authorized, only with hostel pass.
- Visitors are allowed only on Second Sunday (not on holiday) of the month between 9.00 am and 4.00 pm.
- In any emergency, Parents can come or make a phone call between 9.00 am to 12.00 am. to Hostel Number.
- No visitors are allowed in the evening hours on week days. It is strictly forbidden.
- Money or any other things brought for students outside visiting hours should be handed over to the warden sisters.
- Hostel students may be sent for holidays ALONE only with the written permission from the parents.
- Students must arrive in the hostel in due time so as to be present for the college hours (latest by 8.30 a.m. of the re-opening day) late comers will not be entertained.
- Students are not permitted to go out for phone calls or any other purpose without permission. No permission to come as day scholar without warden's permission.
- The students can call twice a week to the parents from hostel phone only and no calls will be received back on the same number. Similarly they can get the phone calls only once a week.
- The students on returning from Home to Hostel shall reach before 5 p.m.
- Money is supposed to be deposited in the Hostel A/C. On line transfer of money is encouraged for all types of payment.
