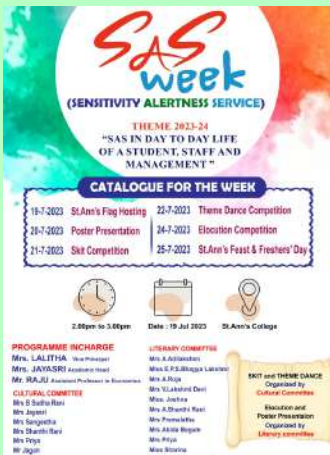

Freshers Day

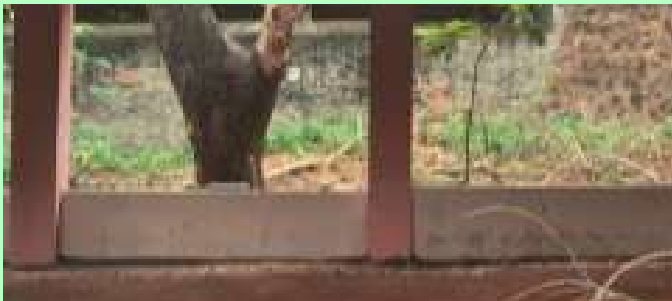

E-Classrooms

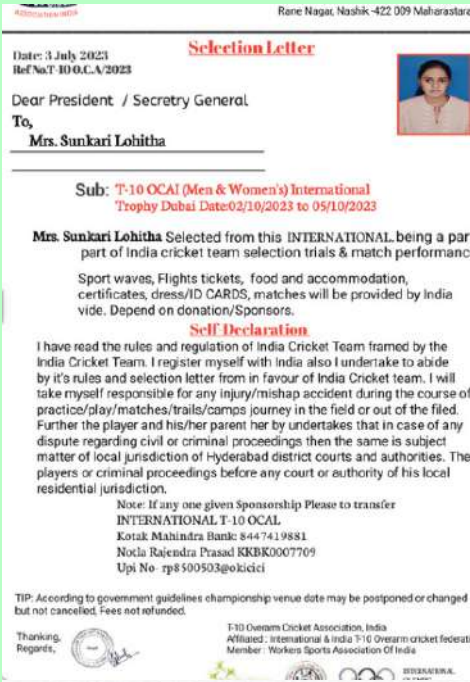
An orientation class has been arranged to give an understanding to the lecturers for the need to conduct digital classes in every college, With the advent of new educational policies.

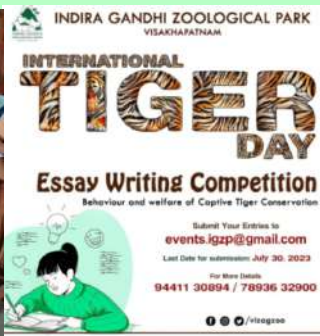


July 11th Population Day was Observed by the dept of library by conducting different competition to aware the students under the guidelines of sireesha Madam library committee coordinator.
