

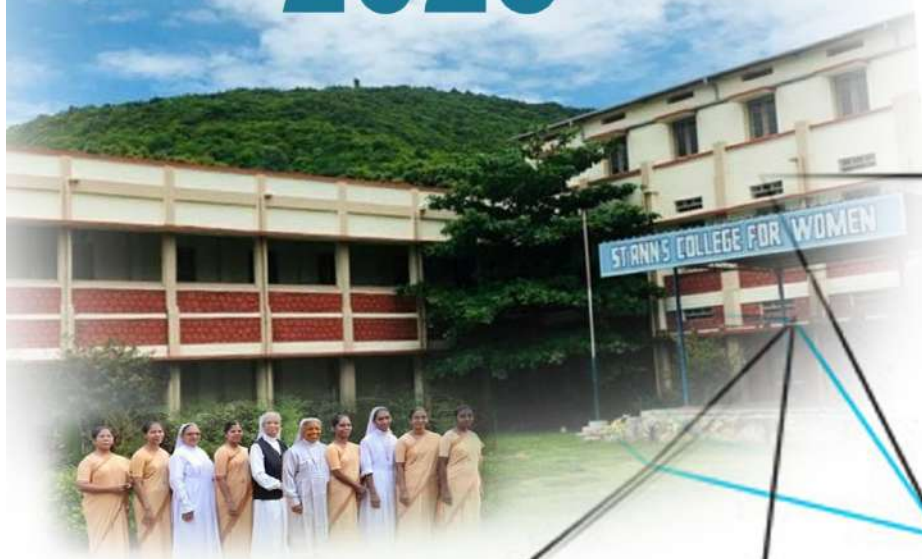

INDEPENDENCE DAY

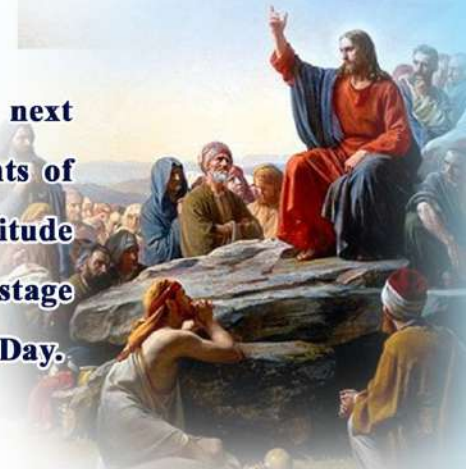

FINANCE INSPECTION

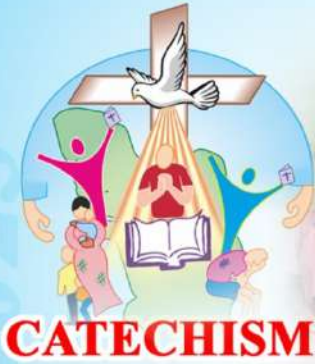

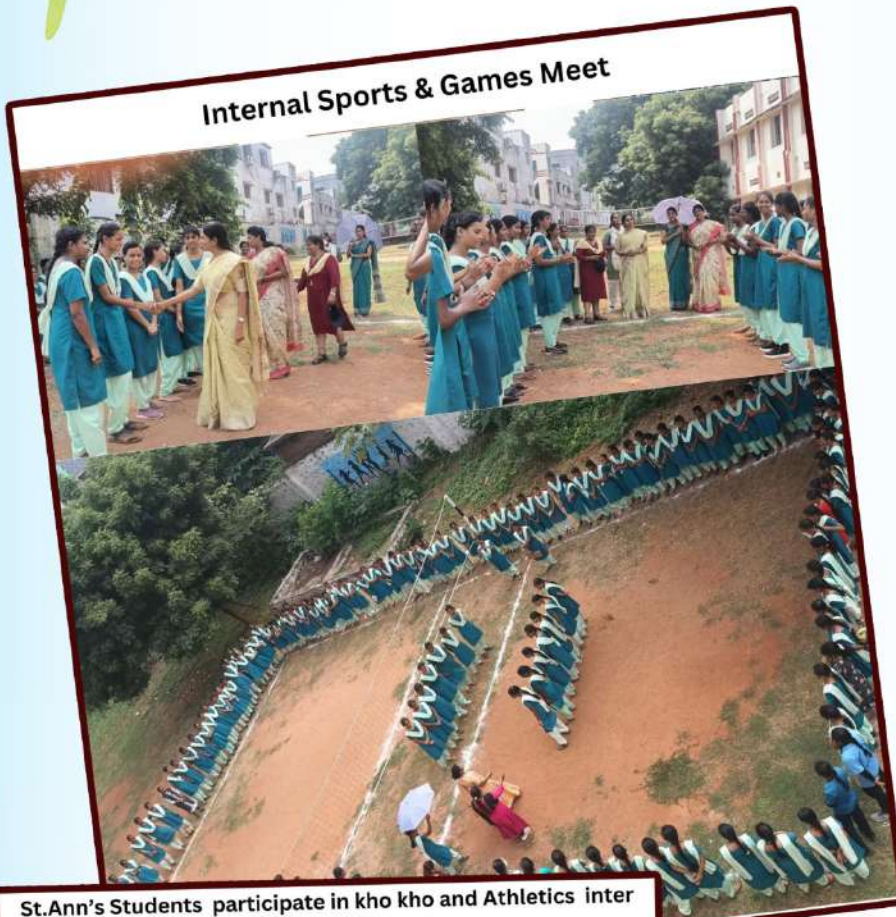
