**HOW TO APPLY:** Application Forms can be obtained from the College Office on payment of Rs. 100/- + Postage if requested by Post. (Postal charges etc.) Application Forms will be issued only after the release of Intermediate Results.

- Application should be registered at the College Office before the prescribed date.
- The following original + 3 xerox copies of the same should be submitted along with the application. Incomplete Application Forms will be rejected.
- T.C., Conduct Certificate, Study Certificate, Marks of the qualifying examination, i.e. Intermediate, H.S.C or I.C.S.E.
- 2. 10th Class Marks list and Aadhaar Card.
- Date of Birth extract. (In Case the date of Birth is not noted in the certificate)
- 4. The Catholic students should submit a certificate from the Parish Priest and Christian students from the Pastor.
- Migration certificate has to be produced by students coming from Different Boards / States.

Candidates seeking admission should be accompanied by a responsible person, Parent or Guardian. Once admitted, the admission cannot be cancelled and the T.C. can't be issued unless it is a genuine case of transfer of the Parents or the college itself issues, T.C. for serious reasons.

#### NOTE:

#### **GENERAL REGULATIONS:**

The students through their application enter voluntarily into an agreement to abide by the following rules and regulations of the college.

- 1. The day begins with a common morning prayer in which all participate.
- The College expects the students to be punctual and regular in attendance for all classes. They are in their class rooms at the first bell which goes 10 minutes before the commencement of the morning/ evening sessions. College timings: 9.00 a.m. to 3.30 p.m.
- 3. A day's attendance requires present at all lectures at both sessions.
- 4. The absentees get prior permission from the Principal. Both the hostel and day students notify their absence from lectures to the Principal through leave notes. Absence without leave notice is subject to penalty.
- Students are to have 80% of the total attendance for each year.
- 6. Students do not leave the college premises during sessions without the permission of the Principal.
- 7. The day students do not enter the hostel quarters.
- Prior permission of the Principal is essential to hold any meeting or gathering in the college premises.
- No books, magazines or newspapers which are in no way related to classes/studies are brought into the campus.
- 10. Students of St.Ann's are to be extra courteous, sensitive, alert, service minded, polite and lady-like in their behaviour.
- Students are expected to be modest in their behaviour and in their dressing. Short sleeves, low necklines, high blouses and low hips are not permitted.
- 12. Electronic gadgets like cell phone, I pads, smart gadgets allowed only on the written permission from parents and as per the need under the guidelines of College Management.
- 13. Parents are requested to attend to all the student welfare meetings conducted by the college.
- 14. On all working days except for College functions, the students should wear the Uniform, I.D. The Uniform will be available in the College.
- 15. No collection/subscription of any kind is allowed without the knowledge and consent of the Principal.
- 16. Change of phone number, residence/address of the students is notified to college office.
- 17. Other than parents and guardian no one is allowed to meet students.
