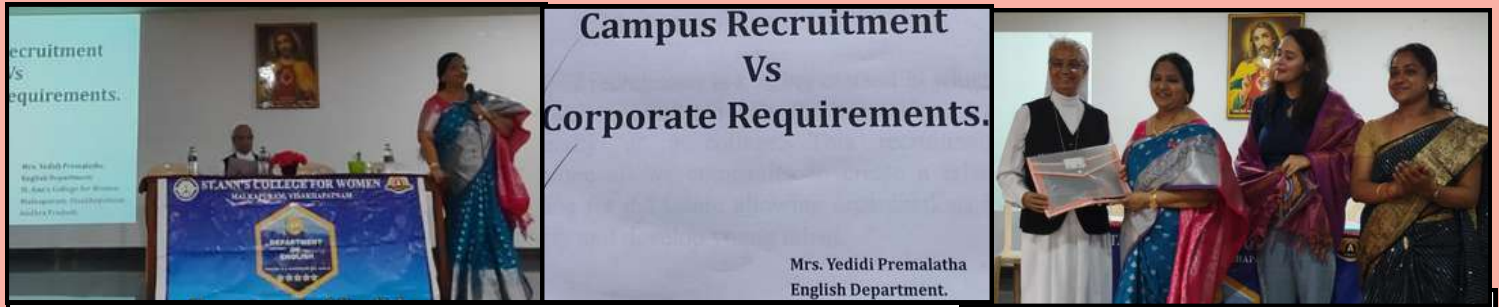
• Consumer Rights Convention

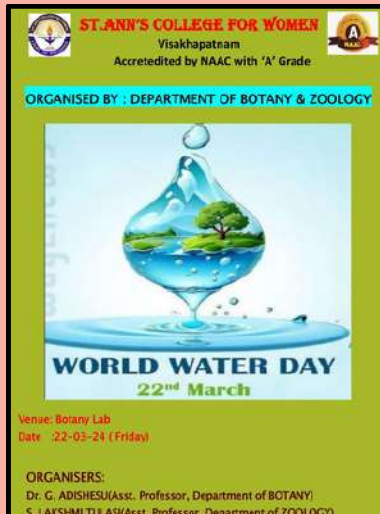
- **Campus v/s Coporate Insights**

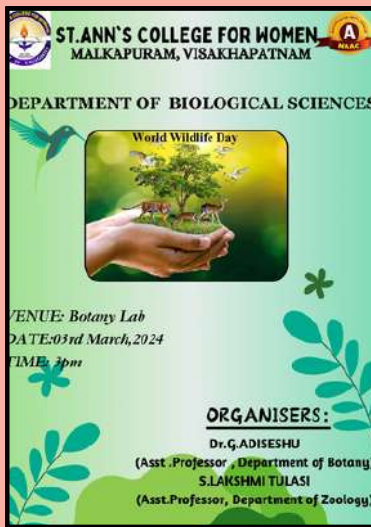


- **World Forestry Day**

• World Oral Health Day



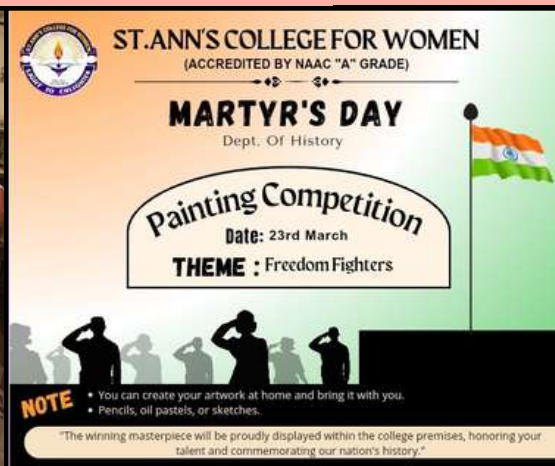

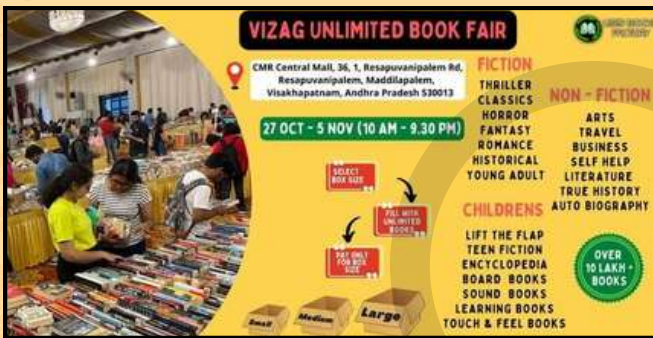
