2-Day Workshop on Learning Techniques for Autonomy in College



Day -1

Session 1:

Introduction to Autonomous Learning in College.

The session addressed on building faculty capacity for autonomous learning, providing support for faculty development and mentoring, and encouraging innovative teaching practices.

• International Yoga Day



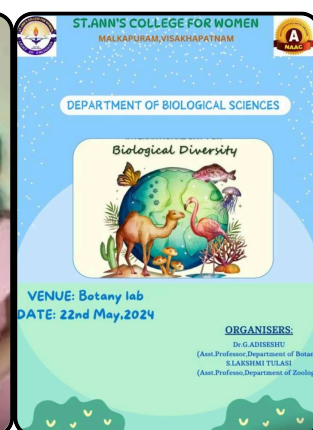

Departmental Activities

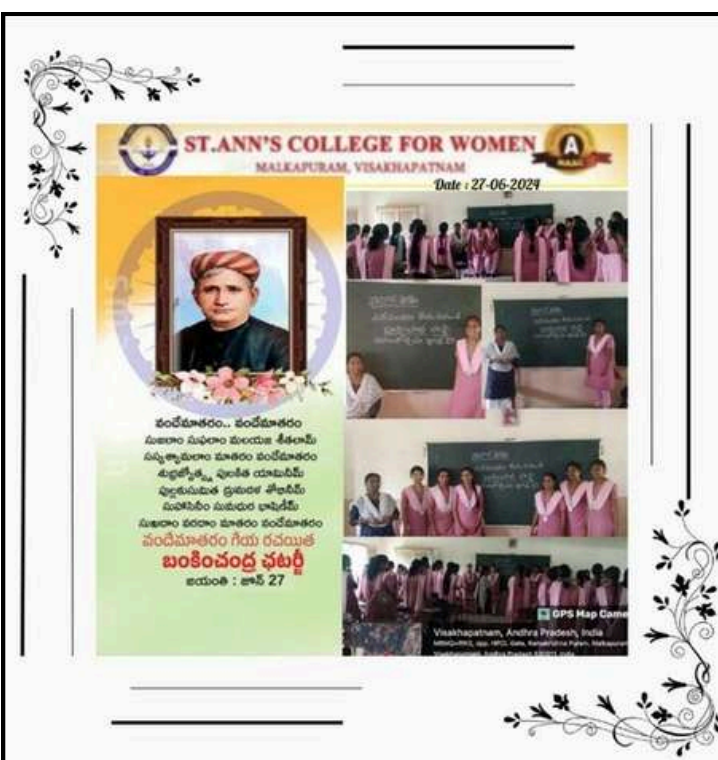
• PPT Week - Dept of Hindi

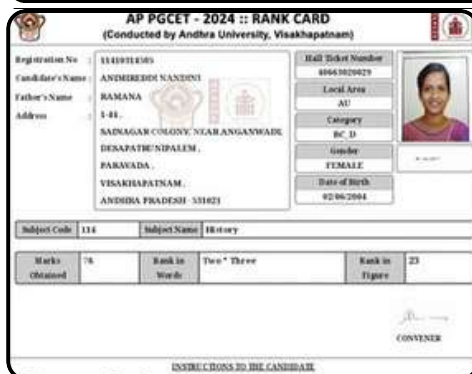

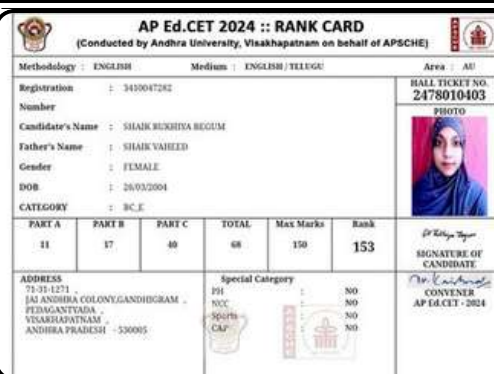
Kota Alekhyia excelled in the exams, securing 3rd rank in the district level, showcasing her academic prowess and dedication, making her family and institution proud.



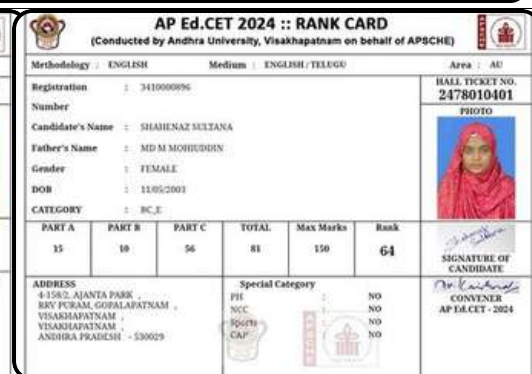
