Author Guidelines

Authorship

- All authors must have made significant contributions to the research and preparation of the paper.
- All authors must have reviewed and approved the final version of the paper.

Conflict of Interest

- Authors must disclose any conflicts of interest that may have influenced the research or preparation of the paper.
- Conflicts of interest may include financial interests, personal relationships, or other factors that may have influenced the research.

Format

- The paper should be formatted in Microsoft Word (.docx).
- The paper should be double-spaced, with 1-inch margins on all sides.
- The paper should use a clear and legible font, such as Times New Roman or Arial.

Instructions

- Authors should follow the instructions provided in these guidelines carefully.
- Authors should ensure that the paper is original and has not been published elsewhere.
- Authors should ensure that the paper is free of errors and is formatted correctly.

Keywords

- Authors should provide 5-7 keywords that reflect the main topics of the paper.
- Keywords should be listed in alphabetical order.

Length

- The paper should be 800-1200 words in length, excluding references, tables, and figures.

Main Paper

- The main paper should provide a clear and concise overview of the research, including the methodology, results, and conclusions.
- The main paper should be divided into sections, including an introduction, literature review, methodology, results, discussion, and conclusion.

Originality

- The paper should be original and should not have been published elsewhere.

- Text alignment: JustifiedTitle alignment: Centered
- Headings alignment: Left-justified

Margins

Top margin: 1 inch (2.5 cm)
Bottom margin: 1 inch (2.5 cm)
Left margin: 1 inch (2.5 cm)
Right margin: 1 inch (2.5 cm)

Line Spacing

- Double-spaced throughout the manuscript
- No extra line spacing between paragraphs

Indentation

- Use a consistent indentation scheme throughout the manuscript
- Use a 0.5-inch (1.3 cm) indentation for the first line of each paragraph

Headings

- Use headings to divide the manuscript into sections
- Use the following heading hierarchy:
 - Title (14 points, bold, centered)

- Use a clear and concise format for equations
- Use Arabic numerals to number equations
 Place equations in the text near the first reference to them

References

- Use the APA style guide for referencingList references in alphabetical orderUse a hanging indent for references

Appendices

- Use a clear and concise format for appendicesUse Arabic numerals to number appendices
- Place appendices at the end of the manuscript
